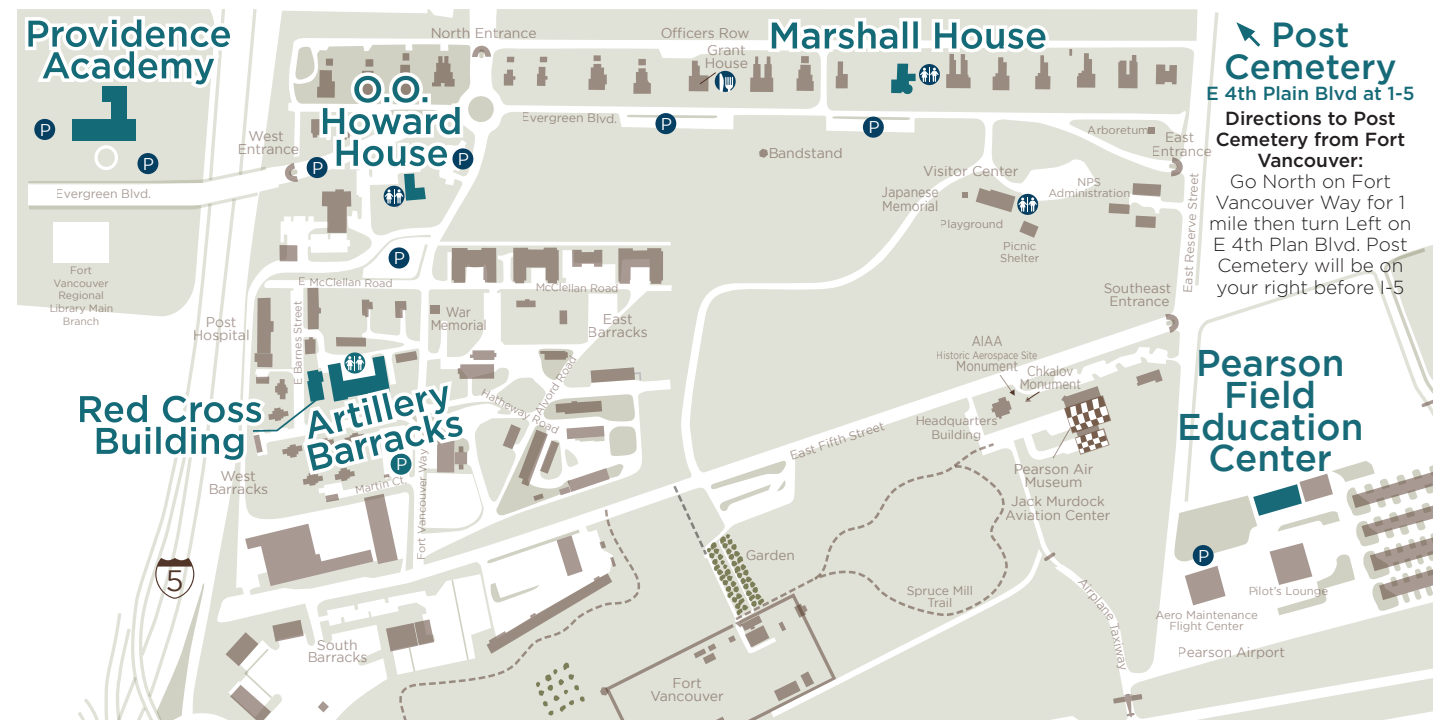

HISTORY TOURS

WALK + TALK: OFFICERS ROW & WEST BARRACKS

For over a century, the late 19th and early 20th century homes on Officers Row served as residential housing for many soldiers, officers, and families stationed at the Vancouver Barracks. The tour finishes at the West Barracks in exploration of the WWI and WWII impact in these iconic U.S. Army Buildings.

WALK + TALK: POST CEMETERY

The Vancouver Barracks Post Cemetery hosts four Medal of Honor recipients. Presented by the Vancouver Barracks Military Association.

WALK + TALK: MARSHALL HOUSE

This tour of the former residence of General George C. Marshall provides insight into the 3 years he was assigned here, the major events that occurred. The home is beautiful, appointed in the Victorian style furnishings and decoration of that era.

WALK + TALK: PROVIDENCE ACADEMY

Built by Mother Joseph of the Sacred Heart in 1873, Providence Academy is one of the most important buildings in Pacific Northwest history. It served as a school, orphanage, and governance offices for the Sisters of Providence.

WALK + TALK: AVIATION HISTORY

Pearson Field Education Center is a unique hangar filled with memorabilia of a by-gone flight era and is now filled with young people engaged in STEM education through the lens of aviation.

WALK + TALK: THE BOTANIC TOUR

A partnership between the City of Vancouver's Urban Forest department, The Historic Trust, and local experts reveals the Botanic Tour of plant, flower, and tree species along Officers Row on Evergreen Boulevard.

THE GORGE EXCURSION: LEWIS & CLARK TRAIL

A full-day trip up the Columbia Gorge on the Oregon side, crossing over at the Bridge of the Gods, and back down the Columbia Gorge on the Washington side. A gourmet picnic lunch, numerous reenactments, expert docent guides, a luxury bus, interactive activities, and a finishing reception await.

EXHIBITIONS

STANDING TOGETHER: WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE

A special exhibition loan from the National Women's Party in Washington DC features the powerful images, words, and political ambitions of American women in their search to secure the right to vote. Coupled with this exhibit is a special lecture, period songs, one-act plays, and a featured public panel discussion.

SP&S IN THE COLUMBIA GORGE: RAIL TRANSPORTATION ON THE COLUMBIA RIVER

A fantastic partnership presentation of the Southwest Washington Model Railroaders and the Clark County Historical Museum, featuring two fully functioning trains on tracks around a layout through scenes of Vancouver, Beacon Rock, Cape Horn, and Maryhill, along with CCHM historic panels. Ages 8-80.

CELEBRATING VANCOUVER BARRACKS: LOWER COLUMBIA VETERANS COALITION

A unique series of military "fashion" shows will be presented on the "runway" porch. Included will be historic vehicle and interpretive displays, educational seminars, and a WWI song concert.
