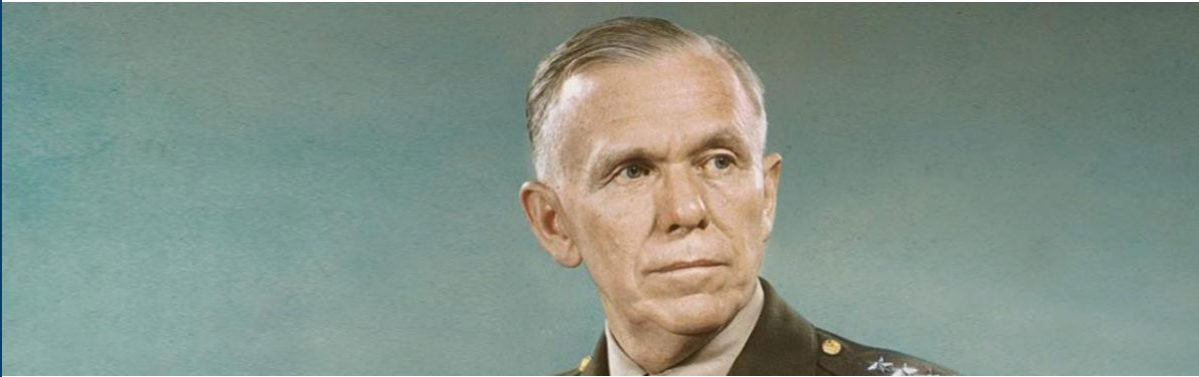


### ***With the Wind and the Stars: Women in Aviation***

**Pearson Air Fair** is a family-friendly, one day event, held at the historic Pearson Air Field, on May 2, 2020. The Air Fair provides aviation-related STEM activities, education/career opportunities, and fans of aircrafts to connect with community partners and area families. This event will provide exposure to approximately 700 guests from Vancouver and the Portland Metro area.

**Vancouver's Fireworks Spectacular** is our largest and most attended event of the year. Reach thousands of people throughout the day with your message. Over 22,000 people attended the Independence Day event last year.

**The Vancouver Chautauqua** is a unique community event, modeled after the iconic chautauquas popular in late 19th and early 20th century America. It brings speakers, teachers, musicians, entertainers and craftspeople together for the exchange of ideas, the telling of stories, and the pleasure of learning. The 2020 Vancouver Chautauqua will host approximately 1,000 guests over six days of lectures, exhibits, and performances.

**The Lough Legacy Veterans Parade** celebrates the service and sacrifice area veterans have made for our freedom in partnership with the City of Vancouver. The parade averages over 110 parade entries and nearly 3,000 attendees and guests.

**Open Saturdays** at the Pearson Field Education Center is open at no cost to youth of all ages every Saturday throughout the year to experience STEM education through aviation. Each Saturday features a lab of flight simulators, a vertical wind table, glider building, historic airplanes and



collections on display, and various educational programs. Second Saturdays feature an aviation-themed presentation and a new STEM activity for kids to explore.

**Let's Take Flight** is our largest fundraiser of the year, benefiting Pearson Field Education Center. The event consists of an exciting live auction, dinner/dessert, and a silent auction all taking place in the hangar on the historic Pearson Air Field.
