Grant House Herb Garden
Six different culinary herbs and several cultivars are used by the restaurant's chef. Dedicated volunteers from the Hardy Plant Society-Clark County maintain the garden.

Howard House Rose Garden
About 100 heirloom roses planted
by the Fort Vancouver Rose
Society include Old Garden Roses
(classes dating to earlier than
1867) like Gallica blooming
May-June. Other vintage varieties
include Rugosas which flower
June into fall.
